CHURCH OF CHRIST THE SAVIOUR

Our church has provided a Christian presence in Ealing for over one hundred years. We are a friendly and joyful church community, welcoming all people and making known God's love for everyone, regardless of their circumstances. However, we are not a rich church and we rely **entirely** on the generosity of our congregation. Last year our income was £134,000 but our outgoings were more, leaving us with a deficit. Our Income has dropped by £70,000 per year over the past 5 years. We need an **INCREASE** in **weekly** giving so that we can continue to support our church community and clergy and continue to have a thriving church.

Planned Giving is a way of giving regularly to help fund the work of our Parish. It aims to help you give generously within your means, and makes it easier for the Parish to fund God's work in Ealing.

Our church needs a minimum of **£3,015 per week** for the work of ministry, worship, service & mission.

£1,550 per week on our share of clergy costs in the diocese- parish share

£965 per week on our building, including insurance, heat, light etc

£500 per week on worship and ministry costs to and in the community, including our church hall

To meet this challenge our planned income target for the year is:

£140,000 from regular giving, including Gift Aid reclaimed from the Revenue

£25,000 from fees, the church hall and our fundraising efforts.

How much should I give?

We all need to give something and whatever we're giving at the moment, we all need to give more. At the moment over half of our planned income is provided by very few people. We all need to share that responsibility.

We are aiming for an average level of giving of **£50 per month** to fund and build on our ministry. Some may not be able to give this amount, and some may be able to give substantially more. Whatever you give should be given with a joyful heart and according to your means.

The Bible teaches us to give a proportion of our income and for many that means a tithe or 10%. You can use the following table to decide what giving a proportion might mean for you.

Weekly income	Giving			
	1% £	2% £	5% £	10% £

How confidential is my giving?

Your level of giving is confidential. The clergy do not know how much you give. The only people who know are the Planned Giving Recorder and the Treasurer. All information regarding the Planned Giving is held securely within the Parish and is not divulged to any outside organisations.

What if my circumstances change?

If you change the amount you give, your name, address, any other contact details or your tax circumstances please inform the Treasurer so that we may make sure our records are correct and up to date.

I am new to the Parish and would like to talk to someone about giving?

Our Parish Treasurer, Churchwardens or Planned Giving Recorder will be able to answer any questions you have about giving to the Parish. Any conversations are held in the strictest confidence.

How can I give?

Regular 'Planned Giving' by Standing Order is the most useful way to give money to the church. If you don't currently give through the bank, please consider doing so. It is easier for you and for us. Alternatively, you can still use the weekly envelopes.

Why should I plan my giving?

It enables us to plan ahead as we know how much money is coming in and it means that you don't miss a week if you are not in church. The church runs for 52 weeks per year, whether you are here or not!

We all share the responsibility to make sure our ministry and mission here in Ealing continues. Jesus instructs us to go out and tell the good news to everyone, and in this Parish we do that in many different ways. All the different styles of worship, teaching and outreach we offer help each of us to grow in faith and to reach out to all.

Our giving funds the employment costs of our Priests, administration, as well as heating, electricity, supplies, upkeep of the church buildings etc, and all that we need to engage in the day-to-day mission of our church. There is also Sunday school, confirmation classes, baptisms, home visits and communions.

Gift Aid

If you pay either UK Income or Capital Gains Tax we can claim 25p for every £1 you donate, at no extra cost to you.
