


Christ the Saviour Ealing

Walsingham, in the heart of Norfolk, is a special place of pilgrimage. For many hundreds of years pilgrims from around the world have sought the grace of God in what is often called *England's Nazareth*. We are fortunate to have booked a weekend in Spring, the best time of the year to visit this holy place.

We shall once again share our pilgrimage with the parish of St Matthew's Westminster, with their parish priest Fr Philip Chester. The weekend is a good time of relaxation, fun and inspiration, and this year there will be a particular focus on *thanksgiving* after two very difficult years of the pandemic. It is a perfect opportunity to deepen our faith and our friendship with one another. For many people Walsingham is a significant place of healing, as we connect to a tradition of prayer that stretches back many centuries.

You can either travel independently by car or travel as a group by train. A group of us will be leaving King's Cross on the morning of Friday 6th May on the direct train to Kings Lynn, from where we shall travel by people carrier to Walsingham. You are responsible for getting your own train ticket, we will arrange the taxis from Kings Lynn for those who want to travel together.
